


FITTING THE BRUSHES TO VERTICAL (A)

For 35mm doors cut brushes (D) to the lengths of (A) and fit to the jamb pocket entrance verticals (A)




ATTACHING THE VERTICALS TO (A) THE STEEL FRAME






Cut verticals (A) to the dimension of X, minus the header's (C) height
